- Leave it to Professionals.
 - o Enjoy public firework displays organized by trained experts.
- Know Your Local Laws

- Keep a Safe Distance
 - o Maintain a safe distance between spectators and fireworks.
- Water Everywhere
 - Have a bucket of water or hose nearby for emergencies and to douse used fireworks.
- Eye Protection
 - Use safety glasses to protect your eyes from potential sparks or debris. Safety first, even when enjoying the displays.
- Children or Pets
 - o Keep children and pets at a safe distance from the fireworks.
- Emergency Plan
 - Have a plan in case of an emergency. Know the location of a first aid kit and emergency contact.
