2025 TRADESWOMAN OF THE YEAR AWARD

Purpose of the Award

The NAWIC Tradeswoman of the Year Award recognizes an outstanding tradeswoman who has demonstrated excellence in her craft, leadership among peers, and a commitment to advancing women in the industry. This award is open to all tradeswomen, regardless of NAWIC membership. A nominee may only win this award once.

Nomination Process

You may self-nominate or nominate someone else. Nominations must include:

- 1. A completed nomination form (below).
- 2. A short essay (500 words max) highlighting the nominee's impact, leadership, and contributions to the industry.

Selection & Judging


A panel of judges, selected by the NAWIC President, will review applications anonymously. The nominee selected will be notified by the NAWIC President and recognized after the National Election results are announced.
